***RE: Urging Support for Senate Position to Fully Fund Housing Trust Funds
(General Government Line Item 2240)***

Dear Chairman Corcoran:

We support full funding of affordable housing trust funds. Through documentary stamps on real estate transactions, the Sadowski Act of 1992 helps some of our most vulnerable Floridians by preventing homelessness, providing sustainable homeownership, and funding emergency repairs and disaster recovery for Florida's most vulnerable residents, including the elderly, persons with disabilities and veterans.

Affordable and accessible housing allows seniors and persons with disabilities to live independently, avoiding public costs of institutional care. Permanent supportive housing for the chronic homeless saves taxpayer dollars by reducing hospital, law enforcement, and other crisis expenses. A fully-funded trust fund would also create about 30,000 jobs and spur \$2.9 billion in positive economic impact next year.

Stemming mainly from past budget deficits, the legislature has swept over \$1 billion from housing trust funds since 2002 for use as general revenue.

Again, we urge support for the Senate's position to fully fund the state and local housing trust funds. Thank you for your consideration of this concern. We are pleased to address any questions you or your staff might have.
